The Keota City Council met on January 14, 2015, in the city hall. The meeting for the budget revenue was called to order at 7:06 P.M. by Mayor Anthony Cansler.

Council Members answering roll call were Westendorf, Hill, and Conrad. Councilwomen Davis arrived shortly after roll call was taken. City employee present was Osweiler.

Motion was made by Greiner to approve the agenda, Hill seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

The council went over each line account for each department asking about the current year to date amounts and asking about the projected amounts for the 2015-2016 budget year. The amount of property taxes has decreases due to the state reform. The council will have to increase the water rates sometime in the next budget year to pay for the water main project mandated by the DNR that will take place this spring and/or summer. Other accounts will see a slight increase due to the increase in certain fees.

Motion was made by Westendorf, seconded by Davis to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:35 P.M. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be on January 20, 2015, in city hall at 7 p.m. in city hall. There will be a budget meeting for the expenses on January 28, 2015, at 7 p.m. in city hall.
