

## JANUARY 4, 2016

The Keota City Council met on January 4, 2016, in the city hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Anthony Cansler.

Council Members answering roll call were Hill, Greiner, Conrad and Davis. Councilman Westendorf was unable to attend the meeting. City employees present were Slaubaugh, Conrad and Osweiler.

Motion was made by Conrad to approve the agenda, Hill seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Conrad to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with the following corrections: change Brain Lewis to Brian Lewis and change untimely to ultimately in the McDonald discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

Kevin Slaubaugh presented the following for the public works report. The new salt supply has been delivered; therefore, the supply is at one hundred percent. He will be working on trying to get the remaining ice and snow off the roads this week. He spoke with the property owner about splitting the cost of moving the street light and the owner will get back with him or attend a council meeting once they have made a decision. Slaubaugh was asked to get a price for moving the pole. He is still working on getting the final estimates for tearing down 510 North Ellis. He was asked to address the sidewalks not be cleared in the business district. Greiner made a motion to approve the public works report, Davis seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Officer Doug Conrad presented the following report for the police department. He issued five citations: operate snowmobile in carless manner/alternative enforcement, three speeding/alternative enforcement and OWI. There were thirty-two complaints/service calls: two theft, controlled substances, family/children, OWI, disorderly conduct, three other criminal violations, traffic accident, nine assist/service, attempt to locate, five misc. complaints, three animal, two traffic violations and two parking. He got his computer back and is working on getting all the software back on it. Motion was made by Greiner to approve the police departments written report, Hill seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

The council will discuss the 16-17 budget revenues starting at 6 p.m. and have normal council meeting starting around 7 p.m. There will be a budget meeting for the expenses on January 25, 2016, at 6 p.m. in city hall.
