JANUARY 25, 2016

The Keota City Council met on January 25, 2016, in the city hall. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 P.M. by Mayor Anthony Cansler.

Council Members answering roll call were Westendorf, Hill, Greiner, Conrad and Davis. City employees present were Slaubaugh, Conrad and Osweiler.

Motion was made by Conrad to approve the agenda, Westendorf seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Officer Conrad presented the police department's budget and explained why a 2.5% pay increase should be given. Slaubaugh went over the park, road, cemetery, water and sewer department budgets. The council reviewed the budget expenditures amounts as a whole. They want to see all the funds final balances when they are put with the revenues. The preliminary final budget will be reviewed at the meeting on the 2nd of February. The pool budget was tabled because there are no applicants for lifeguard and a manger position. There is a pool meeting on the 8th of February to determine the pool budget and policies.

Motion was made by Conrad to give Officer Conrad, Slaubaugh, Frederick and Osweiler a 1.5% pay increase, Hill seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: "Ayes"-Greiner, Conrad, Hill, Davis and Westendorf; "Nays"-None. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Greiner, seconded by Westendorf to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m. The next regular scheduled meeting will be February 2^{nd} at 7 p.m. There will be a pool meeting on February 8^{th} at 6 p.m. in city hall.
