

January 8, 2018

The Keota City Council met on January 8, 2018, in the city hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 P.M. by Mayor Anthony Cansler.

Council Members answering roll call were Greiner, K. Conrad, Bender, Hill, and Westendorf. City Employee present was Hammes.

Motion was made by Conrad to approve the agenda. Bender seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Westendorf to approve the Resolution 2018-3: A Resolution Approving the Budget Amendment. Hill seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Conrad, Bender, Hill, Westendorf, Greiner; Nays – None; Absent: None. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Discussion was held about looking into a building inspector. No decisions were made and the council will discuss further at future meetings.

The council reviewed Revenues for the 2018-2019 Budget. Tax Levy amounts were not decided as the valuations had not been received yet. Sewer rates were discussed and the City Clerk will look back over the Wastewater Project file to see what the Council had previously approved for projected rate increases. No final decisions were made on the Revenues for the budget.

Clerks/Council/Mayor Comments: A request had been made by Scott Flynn to use the City's username and password to apply for the Community Catalyst Building Remediation Program at iowagrants.gov. The Council approved the request to allow Mr. Flynn to use the City's username/password and that Keith Conrad will look over the grant application before it is submitted. The password will then be changed after the process is complete. It was discussed to have Councilman Bender put on the Pool Committee. A resolution will be drawn up to add him formally to the committee.

Motion was made by Westendorf to adjourn the meeting at 8:53 p.m. Greiner seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.
