The Keota City Council met on January 22, 2018, in the city hall. The meeting was called to order at 6:33 P.M. by Mayor Anthony Cansler.

Council Members answering roll call were Greiner, K. Conrad, Bender, Hill, and Westendorf. City employees present were Hammes, Slaubaugh, and D. Conrad. Also in attendance was Lauren O'Neil, HR Green.

Motion was made by Conrad to amend the agenda to add Leander Construction Change Order to the agenda. Greiner seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Conrad to approve the amended agenda. Greiner seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Lauren O'Neil from HR Green presented the council with the change order for the Wastewater Treatment Project including the additional cost from Alliant Energy.

Motion was made by Conrad to approve the Leander Construction change order. Westendorf seconded the motion. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.

The 2nd Reading of Ordinance 261: Adopting the 2017 Keota Municipal Code was read by Hammes.

The council reviewed the expenditures for the 2018-2019 budget. Officer Conrad presented his department's budget. Public Work's Director Slaubaugh presented his budget. The council read over the submitted budgets from the museum and library. The clerk was asked to enter all the expenditures reviewed and present a copy to the council at the next regular meeting.

Motion was made by Westendorf to adjourn the meeting at 9:31 p.m. Greiner seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.
